An Anticipation Guide is a series of statements about the theme of an upcoming lesson. Student agree or disagree with the statements before the lesson. Then revisit their Anticipation Guide after the lesson to connect the statements to the text or lesson content.

Students should have their own copy of the Anticipation Guide (on a computer or paper).
